The Kilauea Neighborhood Association Board has nominated the Magnifera Indica tree (mango) to be deemed an exceptional tree, therefore, protected from unnecessary removal due to potential development.

The tree is the only one threatened from a row of trees planted at the Plantation 75-80 years ago. The man who planted them was named Saiki. He lived at the dispensary building with his family and acted as a nurse, helping those in the hospital during the war.

The tree is located on the west side of the lot. Tax Map Key 4-5-222:333.
