- 1. The venue doesn't seem big enough for any type of expansion.
- 2. Lacking an architectural rendering (such as elevations) and description of landscaping, it was not possible to for the board to consider the visual impact of the building, particularly along the mauka Kuhio Highway, currently so beautifully landscaped by the mini golf.
- 3. Has the project been thoroughly planned? It seems to have matured quickly.
- 4. The fact that a special permit needs to be pulled to impact Ag Land to provide vehicular access for emergency vehicles demonstrates the not so perfect fit of that building in that particular location.
- 5. A septic system is intended to serve the school, future auditorium as well as the mini golf. The suitability and sufficiency of septic for wastewater management, and the ability to monitor is as it is purported located under the driveway is a concern particularly due to the proximity of the Puukumu Stream.
