## II

The location of the principal office of the corporation shall be in Kilauea, Kauai, State of Hawaii, and the specific address of its initial office shall be P. O. Box 36, Kilauea, Hawaii 96754, State of Hawaii.

## III

The corporation shall be organized exclusively for the following purposes:

A. To provide the residents of Kilauea with a forum whereby they will be inspired with a sense of American citizenship and civic consciousness and responsibility.

B. To promote, publicize and actively participate in the civic, educational and social activities of the community;

C. To secure and distribute information relating to the general welfare of the community; and to aid in the enactment of just and beneficial laws;

D. To promote the interest of its members in the welfare of our community;

E. To encourage cordial and friendly relations between our membership and all other organizations;

F. To promote and assist in such activities to conform with the purposes set forth.

## IV

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

## V

The officers shall consist of a President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Sergeant-at-Arms, who shall also serve

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as Directors of the corporation and shall be elected as provided in the By-Laws of the corporation.

VI

There shall be a Board of Directors consisting of not less than three members. The following persons shall be the initial officers and directors, and shall hold office for the first year or until their successors are duly elected pursuant to the By-Laws of the corporation.

VII

The corporation shall have only such powers as provided for by law necessary to accomplish its stated purposes.

VIII

The corporation is organized for community purposes only and is not organized for profit, it will not issue any stock, and no part of its assets, income, or earnings shall be distributed to its members, directors, or officers, except for services actually rendered to the corporation. Upon dissolution, all of the assets of the corporation after payment of its just debts shall be transferred or distributed to an organization or organizations as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Charter, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.
