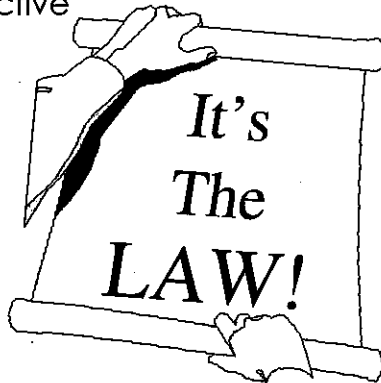

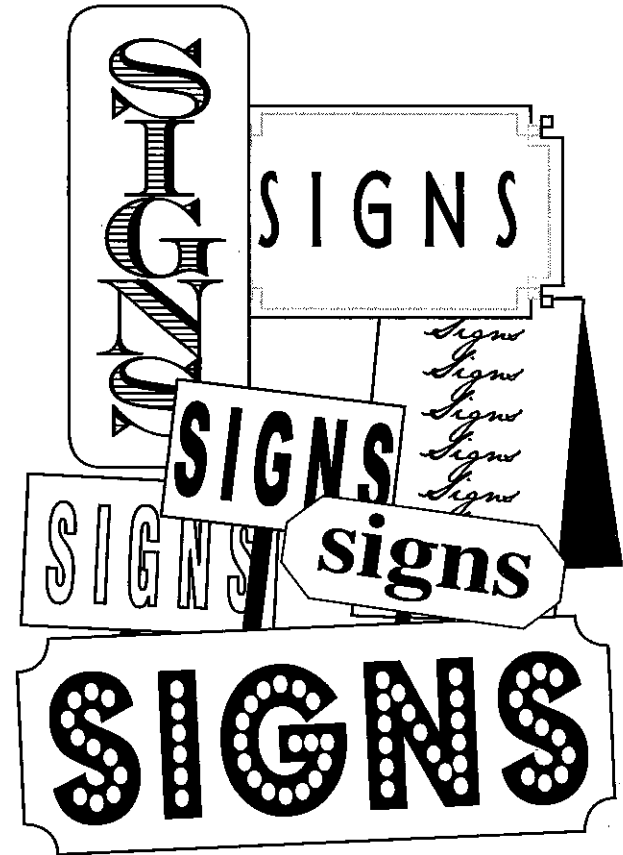

general guidelines for signs

The County of Kaua'i's sign ordinance has specific rules relating to the size, shape, location, placement, construction materials, height off the ground, distance above building, supporting material, lighting, etc. So, before constructing your sign, please check the code's requirements.

THESE SIGNS NEED A PERMIT

Signs in Business Districts
Signs in Industrial Districts
Subdivision Identification Signs
Marquee or Wall Signs
Directional Signs
Ground Signs
Project Signs
Shopping Center Signs
Office building Signs
Gasoline Service Station Signs
Banners or Pennants
Corporate Logo Flags
Theater Signs

THESE SIGNS DO NOT NEED A PERMIT

Temporary Real Estate Signs
Temporary Political Signs
Institutional Signs
Noncommercial Public or Informational Signs
Gateway Signs
Flags
Address Signs
Ingress or Egress Signs

PROHIBITED

- PORTABLE SIGNS
- ROOF SIGNS
- NEON SIGNS
- FLASHING, MOVING or WIND DRIVEN SIGNS
- Signs which obstruct vision of drivers
- Signs which block sidewalks
- OFF-PREMISE SIGNS except as specifically permitted
- Multiple signs may be prohibited
- SPECIAL EVENT BANNERS or PENNANTS displayed longer than 4 days prior or 1 day following an event
- Sandwich signs
- A-frame signs

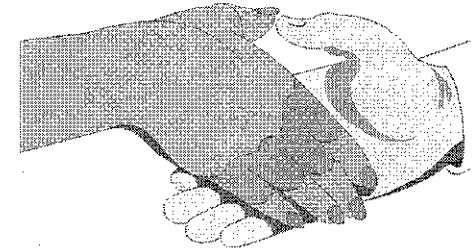

enforcement

The Public Works Department is responsible for the enforcement of the sign ordinance. The Building Division is in charge of permitting the signs.

WHAT HAPPENS WHEN A SIGN IS NOT IN COMPLIANCE?

1. Notice is given.
2. Compliance or removal must take place within 5 working days.
3. Failure to comply: a fine of up to \$50 per day, for every day of violation.
